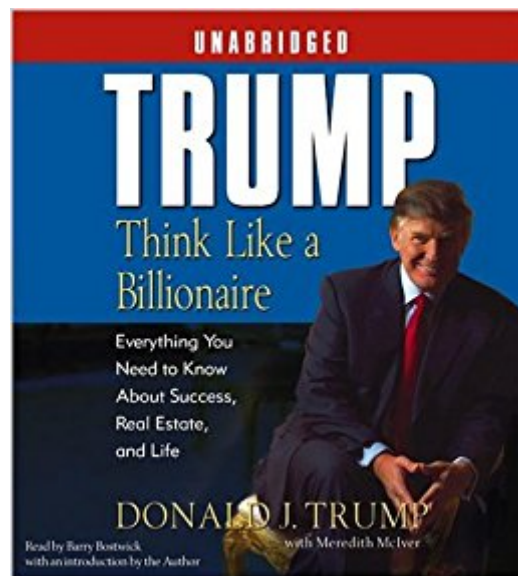

There's no one better at promoting Donald Trump than the man himself. In this slim guide, which Trump says readers should consider "the second part of an ongoing conversation between you and The Donald" (the first part being his previous book, *How to Get Rich*), he offers his two-cents on everything from picking a mortgage broker and selling a house to dressing and grooming for work. Unfortunately, the book is packed with more clichés and glowing comments

about his various properties (including his Mar-a-Lago resort, "one of the most beautiful places on earth") than practical advice. For instance, his advice on how to spot a fraud is, "If it seems too good to be true, it is," and his counsel on grooming is, "Dress for the job you want, not the job you have." Even his "Mar-a-Lago Diet" boils down to eating balanced meals. Each topic is covered in two pages or less, even big ones like How to Sell a House and How to Manage Debt, while other segments—such as A Week in the Life, which superficially covers a rather uneventful week in Trump's life—run on far too long. The final third of the book consists of a teaser for the new season of The Apprentice. Trump provides a general overview of the first four episodes, but doesn't give away any specifics about who gets the boot. Instead, he coyly says, "My first firing wasn't terribly difficult, although I always feel bad for the first person to go because he or she will miss out on so much." Though Trump claims in the book's introduction that "if you absorb only ten percent of the wisdom in this book, you'll still have a good shot at becoming a millionaire," many a reader will likely finish this book feeling distinctly unenlightened. I wanted to learn from The Donald, so I bought this audiobook which consists of 5 CDs. CDs 1, 2 and 1/3 of 3 are great because they represent and discuss the principles implicated by the audiobook's title. However, the remaining 2/3's of CD 3 and CDs 4 and 5 should have been sold separately under the title "The Donald's Typical Week and Pageantry." I am interested in learning about money, finance management, various forms of investing, and, financial growth. While I don't mind learning a bit about Mr. Trump's daily appointments and involvement with pageants, hearing that information is not why I purchased this audiobook. So, I replay the first 2-1/3 CD and leave the remaining ones in the case. Whenever I re-hear the information The Donald is expounding, I learn more and more from it and see how it applies in my life and supports my financial goals and growth. I wish all 5 CDs were used to expound rather than some being used to self-promote.

Let's admit up front that if you are a Donald Trump fan, and I am, you are going to buy this book just because Donald Trump wrote it. That said, the book is a fast, easy read with a few gems that you might find useful. The rest is the usual "look at me and what I've got" found in earlier books. Don't

buy it if you really think that Donald is telling you much about buying real estate. I really liked the fact that the photos are in color - a big step up from earlier books. It is one for my Donald Trump collection, NOT for my business education.
