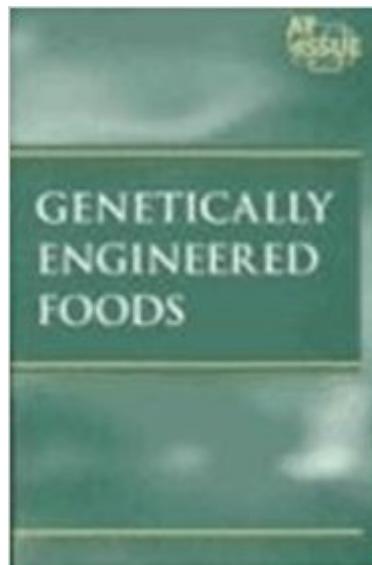




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At Issue Series - Genetically Engineered Foods (paperback Edition)
