

Great book because it is new.... but I had a bit of a hard time gaining my bearings with this. Also wish it had more opinions regarding priorities.

I am really impressed with this Berlin Tour Book/Guide Book as I plan to visit Berlin in 2018. This guide was updated in March 2017. I don't know if the book is updated annually and I am not quite clear who the publisher is, but I think it would be a good idea to print 2017 in bold numbers directly on the front. This would make it easier for the user to understand how current the information is. As for content, I am impressed. I love that there is a history time-line for Berlin which starts in Year 720 and end in 2016. I also love that the author lists some recommended reading, some of which is starred. There certainly were some historical books of interest to me. I have been trying to get more of my local libraries to get more copies of this book for their shelves. As for hotels and restaurants, I will probably supplement with other resources such as Michelin. For a small light-weight book, this guide is packed with information on the various Berlin districts, what to see, what to do, what is outside of Berlin, eating and accommodations, drinking and nightlife, the arts, vocabulary, maps, etc.

I'm usually a Lonely Planet reader and in fact I also bought one for this trip, but I checked this out of the library and really enjoyed reading it better. So much that I'm going to also buy it for my Kindle. I haven't been on my trip yet so can't comment on the accuracy

This map is one of those maps that you need to pull open and spread out. It's complete and of that sturdy material that doesn't rip, but if you are looking for something that you can pull in and out of your bag for a quick look where you are, this is not it. The Streetwise Map is excellent and much more convenient.
