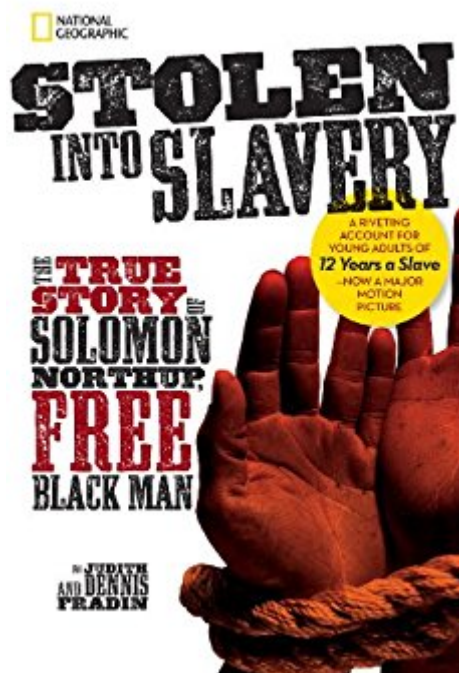




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Stolen Into Slavery: The True Story Of Solomon Northup, Free Black Man (History (US))
