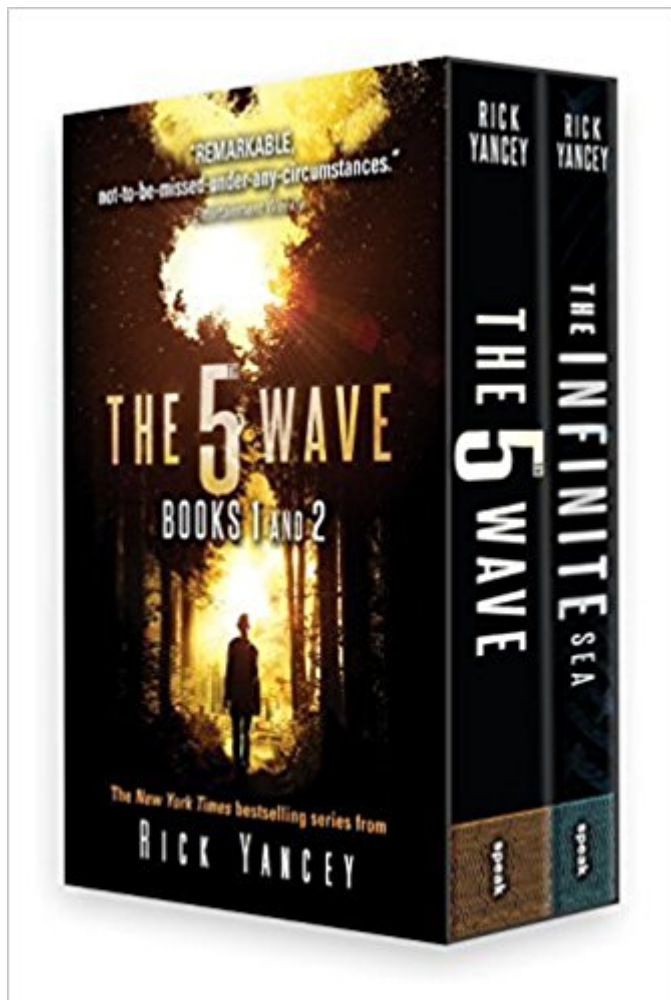


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The 5th Wave (Book 1 & 2)
