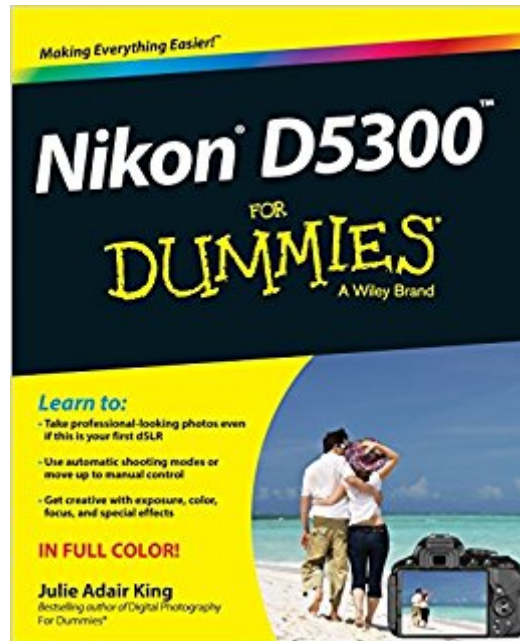

So far, this guide has been quite useful. A large part of the text is generic camera science applicable to any camera, but specific to the D5300 when it needs to be. Understand that it is intentionally general when it comes to the lenses since there are dozens of options available, but the science behind it is helpful enough to work.
