

I agree with folks that many of the patterns in this book are not as appealing as the first book and I also do not like the lack of a difficulty level for each quilt as well. And the thing that is really bothering me about this book is that in the instructions they list the fabrics you need how much you need and give each fabric color a number (fabric 1, fabric 2 etc etc etc) But when they get to the piecing instructions they only refer to the fabric by a color! I do not know about you all but when I make a quilt I choose my own colors and do not attempt to make an exact duplicate of the sample quilt in the book. So it caused me several errors and some pieces getting cut that never needed to be cut! I had to write in my book what fabric numbers went with each group of piecing so I would not keep making mistakes. This book is supposed to be for all skill levels but that oversight alone makes it

far more difficult to make a quilt than it should. I do not honestly recall having this issue with the first book and as that book is in storage I am not currently able to see if this is a fault with both books or just this one. I am glad I only bought a used copy of this book and I am not too sorry I bought it but I cannot wait to finally be able to find the first book and use that one as my primary with this book used only for minor inspirations.

I had previously checked this book out of the library and spotted a quilt in it that was perfect for my granddaughter. So, I made the quilt for her for Christmas, and I purchased this book for her to show her the inspiration quilt. The book was able to give her an idea of what all went into the making of the quilt and the vignettes from the Quilt Makers Gift showed her how special quilts are. She was thrilled with both.
