

I purchased the book with the subheading "Felling Trees" in mind, yet when I received the book, there was not much to be learned in terms of techniques within. The felling aspect of the book focuses entirely on the method of roping a tree, cutting it and pulling it. Not much mention of wedges, let alone different style cuts to drop trees where you want them. Just cut and tug according to this author. Some of the history and safety aspects might be helpful to some, yet if you are at all serious about cutting trees, I would shy away from it. You're better off getting "To Fell a Tree" by Jeff Jepson.
