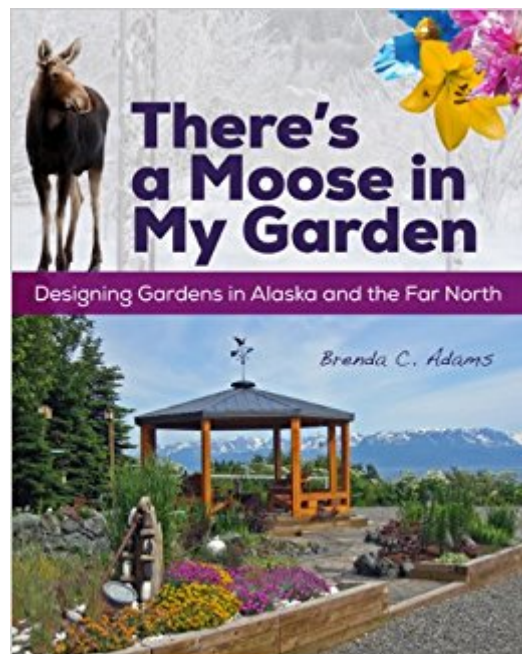




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There's A Moose In My Garden: Designing Gardens In Alaska And The Far North
