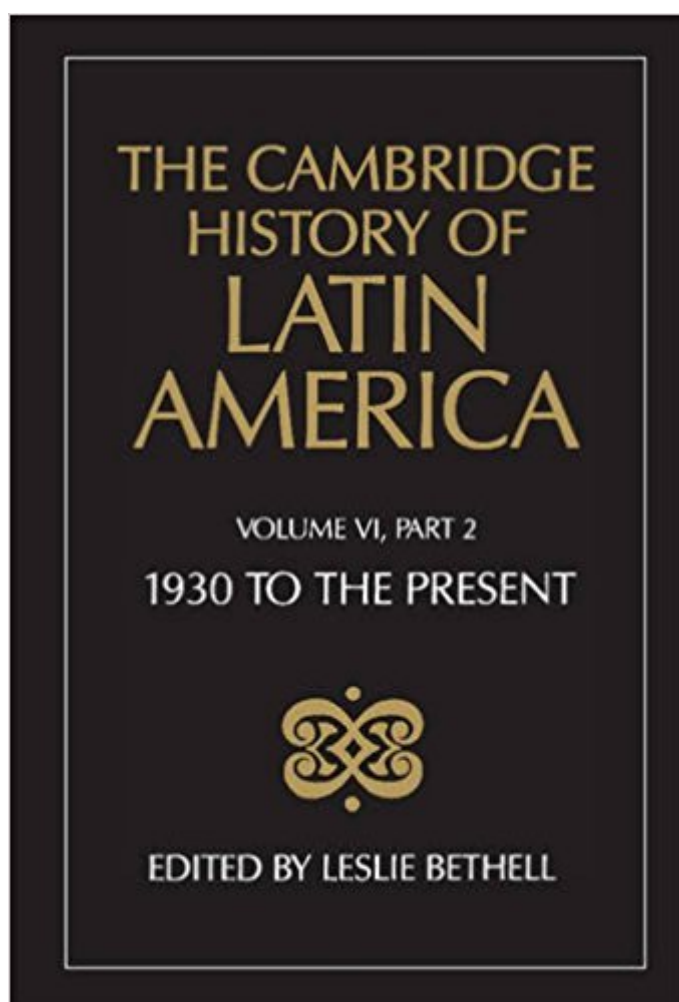


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The Cambridge History Of Latin America, Volume 6, Part 2: Latin America Since 1930: Economy, Society And Politics: Politics And Society
