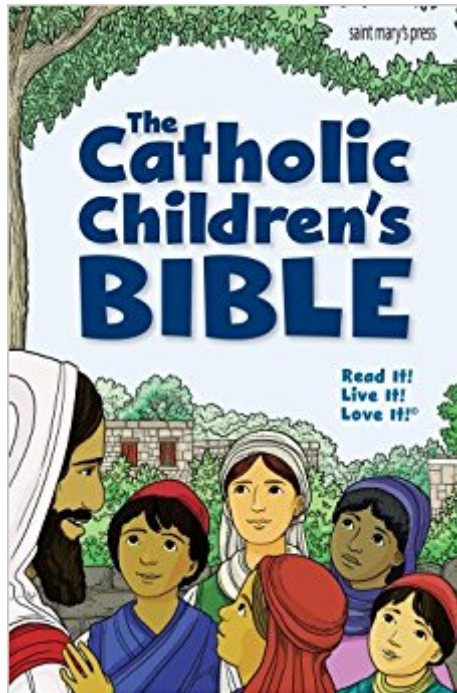

I regret buying the paperback because the bible is heavy and the pages are wrinkling making it look pretty beat up. So buy the hardcover. It has great content; our children are obviously using it a lot. It has many drawings and commentary while being a complete bible.

The best I have found, so easy to understand. It makes a perfect First Communion Gift. I even use it myself and have recommended it to many parents of the CCD classes. It is a bible a child can use the rest of their life.

The Gospel stories are beautifully written, in a simple yet profound way. I am far from being a "child," but I would choose this translation over the several bibles I currently own. The BIG PROBLEM is the size and weight of the book. It would have been much better to print the Old and New Testaments as separate books. Also, the print is too close to the spine, forcing the reader to "bend" the book -- which, because of its size and weight, is impossible.

LOVE that there is finally an entire Catholic Bible that is more reader friendly for kids!! This Bible is very well put together and is good for really any age. My only wish is that they had the option for a more grown up looking cover.

I really enjoy the parts of the chapters that have the featured stories in it. There they have: understand it, love it, and tell it. I do wish, however, that all the chapters were featured stories. That's why I put this as a 4 star and not 5. When I bought it, I thought they all were going to all be featured in that awesome way, but weren't! It was like a normal bible, but was user friendly and organized much better. I hope the next St. Mary's Press children's bible will do all chapters as featured, and somehow make it all fit.

So far I like this bible. I teach RCIA for children this year I have two third graders who will be baptized into the catholic faith in two years. This bible will give me plenty to work on with them. Some people do not like a few of the words used "intercourse" for one. My view of this is that intercourse is what happened and most third graders have heard the word before. And, well Noah did drink too much wine and he did sober up. Personally might prefer a gentler approach but is not enough to make me dislike something that is so good in other ways.
