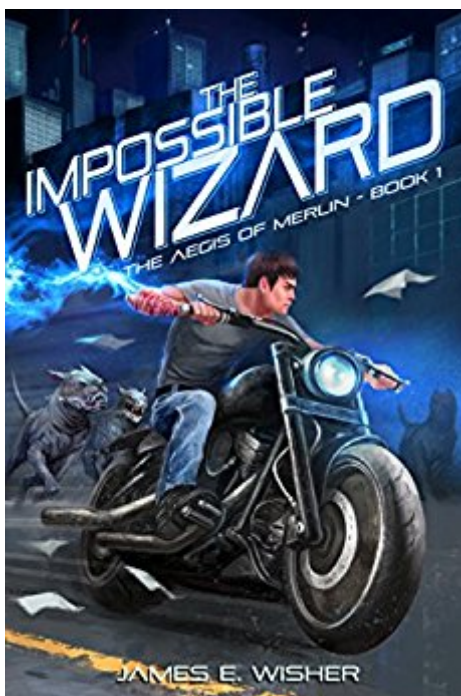


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The Impossible Wizard: The Aegis Of Merlin Book 1

I bought this book with the understanding that the story was about a recently discovered wizard. It was not, this book is mostly about the investigation that the police play in trying to find the group that attempted to murder him. It honestly felt like this book was a spin off of a preexisting series. I didn't

like it, I was really excited about the development of the main character, it never happened. I was thoroughly bored for about 80% of this book. It's not badly written, it's just not for me.

This book is entertaining, fun and moves along fairly well. Unfortunately it goes nowhere. This is one of four in a series and the author has not yet written the last two books. Frankly it should never have been released as a stand alone book. The author ignores trying to make this book a stand alone story and it clearly revels in sucking you into a storyline that requires buying the entire series. If the author meant this to be read as a complete set he should have published them all together or even as one omnibus. Maybe I am alone in hating incomplete stories but they really gripe me. When the series is finished I may endorse it. If the story was more complete I would give it four stars as the characters are engaging, the writing easy to read and the magical world seems consistent.

Given that the plot and basic setting are, for those already generally familiar with the genre, rather bland and predictable, it certainly does not help things that the characters, teenagers and adults alike, display the judgement, maturity and emotional range of young children. Not for adult readers.

This book was advertised as an adventurous fantasy but written as a mystery. The Main character spends very little time in the spotlight and is for the most part a package others carry and protect. As a mystery it was well written, as a fantasy. not at all.

The main protagonist has issues, at times I had to quit reading and take a break from it for a day or two. When it finally enthralls me I can't put it down, everything else is secondary. This did not do that for me. I do like all the other characters, I'm just not into stories with ego driven psychopath villains. This lady Raven is right there with Hannibal the cannibal..etc..

This book seems to be more about setting the scene for our characters. Conryu, our supposed major character, doesn't seem to feature much in this book, as it is more devoted to the detective, Lin Chang, and the magical researcher, Terra. Not bad, but not fully engaging with our hero.

Excellent start to a series. There is plenty of action and intrigue. Start with a young man coming of age with having to adjust his life long dreams and scrutiny of being instantly famous. Throw in people

hunting him and out to destroy the city and you have a good story.

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
