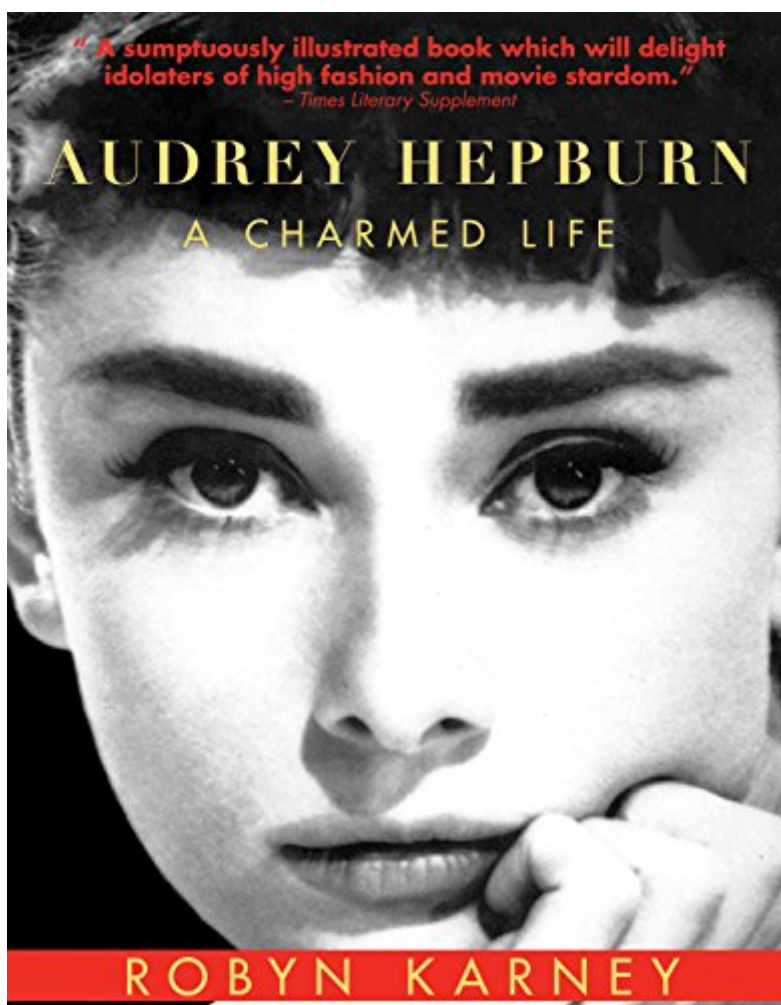

Hepburn's style was perfection, and her clothes—many of them designed by Givenchy, who dressed her for *Funny Face* in 1957—placed her on the world's Best-Dressed Women list for several consecutive years. Her personality and sensuous yet untouchable beauty made her irresistible to the public. On Hepburn's death, Liz Taylor said, "God has a most beautiful new angel now that will know just what to do in heaven."
