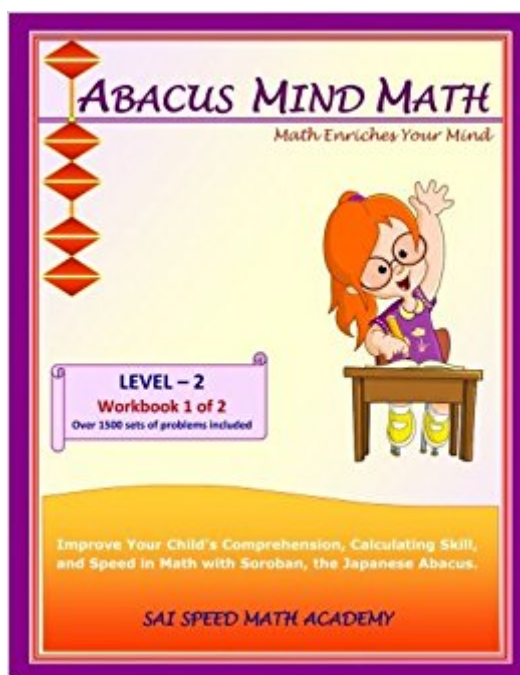


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Abacus Mind Math Level 2 Workbook 1 Of 2: Excel At Mind Math With Soroban, A Japanese Abacus

In general, when children practice mind math, they get a very important sense of achievement that helps raise their confidence as students.
