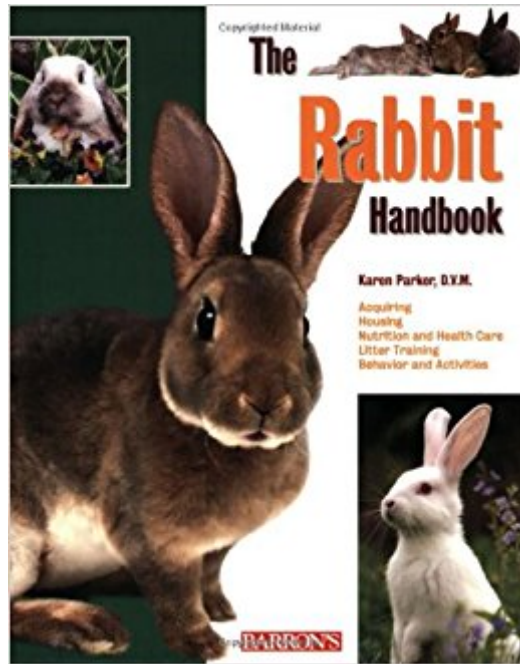

If you are going to breed or show rabbits, this is a great book. If you are just going to have a single rabbit as a pet (like me), the Dummies book is sufficient if not better. I bought both books (small cost compared to the rabbit), but you only need one. The Rabbit Handbook was written by a vet, and it shows in the excellent section about health and medical issues. The sections on feeding were more comprehensive than the Dummies book. It gets 4 stars since it dives deep in areas most owners won't need, and is shallow on other practical topics. But you can't go wrong, it is still a good book.
