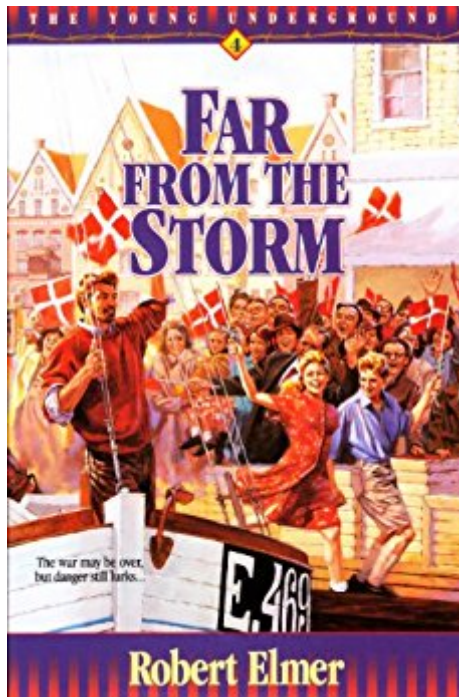




The book was found

Although there is a great mystery in this book which keeps you, the reader guessing, the greatest thing for me to read about was Peter and his new faith. Peter became a Christian in Book 2 - Beyond the River - and we have seen him struggle. In this book, with the war ended, Henrik his best friend, a Jew, has returned from Sweden. Sadly Henrik's dad is very sick and so him and Henrik's

mom have had to stay in Sweden. In the meantime. Henrik is staying with Peter and his family. Peter really wants to witness to Henrik one morning when Henrik sees Peter reading his Bible. Peter becomes tongue tied and can't get the words out. I really congratulate the author on broaching this. I personally think it is encouraging to youngsters to realize they are not the only one! Even as adults, we know we should be witnessing but many of us often struggle. At the beginning, some Germans leaving town, run over Tiger, Peter's cat. He is not killed but suffers a broken leg. Peter is very bitter. He knows all the way through the story that forgiveness is necessary. It is not until the end that Peter truly forgives. What brings him to this move? Uncle Morten and Lisbeth are also back from Sweden and wedding plans are being made. Will they make it to the altar? Who is sending the kid-like threatening notes? Is it Keld Poulsen, the bully or could it be someone else? A good, clean adventure book for children that teaches them values along with some true historical facts. Purchase with confidence! World War II has finally ended. Celebrations for this victory are everywhere. The Danish soldiers are coming home and the German soldiers are leaving the country. Peter's family and friends seem to be forgiving the Germans already, but Peter (just a twelve-year-old boy) can't find it in his heart to do that yet. Obviously someone else hasn't forgiven the war's effects, because that person is after Uncle Morten. Dangerous threats and a big fire have to take place... before Peter, his sister Elise, and their friend Henrik can figure out who the clues are pointing to. Excellent book -- especially to be enjoyed by young Christian kids and teens. I'm looking forward to book 5!

When the Germans leave Denmark at the end of the Second World War, Peter harbors considerable ill will towards them. It doesn't help matters that, on the very eve of their departure, a German truck hits his cat. The next morning, the Danish soldiers return en masse along with his beloved Uncle Morten. But the joy of his uncle's return is marred by a message delivered the night before: "When Morton returns, he burns". Peter's unease, shared by his sister, proves warranted when someone sets fire to their uncle's boat. When Peter's best friend, a Jewish refugee living in Sweden, returns he joins Peter and his sister in uncovering the plot against Uncle Morten. It is at once a well written mystery with believable characters and a story of a young man's search for forgiveness in the aftermath of war and occupation. I wanted to give this book five stars but poor formatting proved to be too much of a distraction.

My 11 year old son is really enjoying this series. He is learning a lot about what it was like for the

Danish during WWII and just after it ended.
