

I just recently found Greg Easter's youtube channel, which is wonderful, but the life he's lead leading up to now is even more interesting. 40 Years in One Night is a whirlwind tour through the past of a man who started a successful TV repair business having never even opened a TV, got his first programming job less than 24 hours after seeing a computer for the first time, and spoofed his way into cooking in a 2-Michelin star restaurant for an evening because he was served a sub-par lamb curry dish and they had a new hire that shared his name. It's a quick read akin more to a verbal (probably lightly photoshopped) scrap-book than a full autobiography, but it's worth your time.
