

After I was shown an xray of my dog's abdomen at the vet's office I realized I don't have a clear idea of where the organs are in a dog. The book includes detailed drawings of the bones, muscles, internal organs, blood vessels, and nerves. For the skull the book shows variation in head shapes (think bulldog versus greyhound). Although it is overly detailed for the typical dog owner, I find it interesting because I teach human anatomy and I am just learning where everything is located in a dog. I think this book would be most useful for vet techs but dog breeders and trainers would probably also find it useful.

It is comprehensive, yet easy to understand. My current students looked at the copy that I ordered and several of them are planning on ordering it as well!
